For example, we know that drugs often have limitations when controlling chronic pain, and we're increasingly aware that there are powerful avenues to pursue for helping patients with mental health problems that don't rely on a prescription pad. A significant number of people with chronic disease need a more individualised and holistic approach to their care, one that seeks to minimise the sometimes adverse effects of conventional medical treatment and to prevent harm. When lifestyle measures alone are insufficient or inappropriate, CAM can prove more effective than conventional options.
